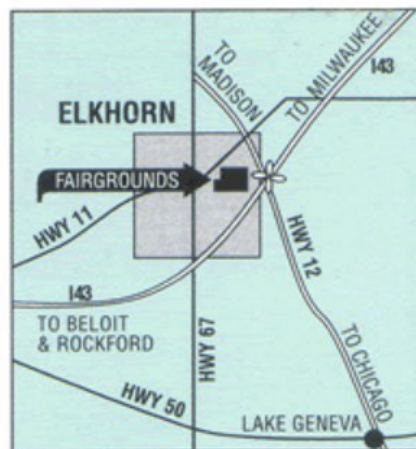

New Safe Sport Training Requirement

Approved August 27, 2018

Safe Sport USEF Rule Part 3

1. Every USEF member and Federation Participant* shall abide by USEF's Safe Sport Policy and the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code of Conduct. **As described by the USEF Safe Sport Policy, a Federation Participant is any USEF member or non-member, who participates in, or attends a USEF-licensed competition or sanctioned event.*
2. In order to comply with S.534, the Protecting Young Victim's from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017, the USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Center's SafeSport Code of Conduct, every USEF adult member and USEF participant, with the exception of the victim, is required to report suspected sexual misconduct within 24 hours to the appropriate authorities and to the U.S. Center for SafeSport.
3. **Beginning January 1, 2019, every USEF adult member with a Competing Membership must complete USEF's Safe Sport Training**, as approved by the U.S. Center for SafeSport (the Center). BOD 8/27/18.

A 30 day grace period to complete the awareness training will be provided to all members when they renew or join. Those who do not complete the training within the grace period will be ineligible to participate in USEF activities, including competitions.

US Equestrian President Murray Kessler stated, "I am very proud of the work done in drafting this proposal and the Board of Directors which approved this critical rule designed to keep our children safe while they enjoy, excel, and advance in our sport."

US Equestrian CEO Bill Moroney told a Safe Sport Town Hall that "US Equestrian is committed to creating and maintaining an equestrian community where all persons who participate in the sport can do so in an atmosphere that is free of emotional, physical, and sexual misconduct. Abuse of any kind has no place in our sport or any sport."

The Safe Sport Policy and the rules that govern it have been created to protect all athletes from misconduct within the sport. This new rule is consistent with our efforts to ensure the safety and welfare of equestrian participants, especially minors. Education and training everyone is crucial to protecting athletes and eradicating abuse in our sport.

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See GR845 for Documentation Requirements.

Show Rules, Entry Fees & Stabling Information

- 1. The Baroque Horse of the Midwest Regional Championship Show** is a US Equestrian (Federation) licensed competition. Every Andalusian, Friesian & USEF Open to All Breeds class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. The rules of the Federation take precedence over the rules of any other association. Exhibitors are encouraged to refer to the current Federation Rule Book, which is available online at www.usef.org. A Federation Steward approved by the Show Committee shall be present to administer these rules at the show.
- 2. Opportunity Classes:** Will be conducted in accordance with USEF rules. There will be no USEF membership requirement for Opportunity Classes. Entries may show in other classes at this show if their breeding allows.
- 3. Rules & Specifications** for All Breed Opportunity classes are contained in this booklet. If you would like a paper copy, please contact Sandy Jacob at 608-201-5922. Show rules will be available in the horse show office. USEF/Andalusian & Friesian Show rules are also available at www.USEF.org.
- 4. All Andalusian and Half Andalusian** horses must be registered with or application for registration has been made to IALHA. (See AL101.1 for remainder of rule.) **All Friesian and Part Bred Friesian** horses must have received a certificate of membership from the International Friesian Show Horse Association (IFSHA) (See FR101).
- 5. The Horse Show Executive Committee** reserves the right to itself, to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to, the show, without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any question not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, their decision to be final. The Horse Show Executive Committee is to consist of Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary, Andalusian Representative & Friesian Horse Representative.
- 6. All entries** are accepted with the understanding that the Baroque Horse of the Midwest Regional Championship Show and the Walworth County Fairgrounds will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or any injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the Federation, the Baroque Horse of the Midwest Regional Championship Show and the Walworth County Fairgrounds against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.
- 7. To be eligible to participate** as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above, Dressage Competitions, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Endurance Rides, Reining Competitions, Para-Equestrian Competitions and Vaulting Competitions, persons must be Members of the Federation as provided in Bylaw 201.
- 8. USEF STATEMENT:** Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
- 9. All owners and exhibitors** will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Walworth County Fairgrounds properties on the showgrounds and will be billed accordingly.
- 10. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above-described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

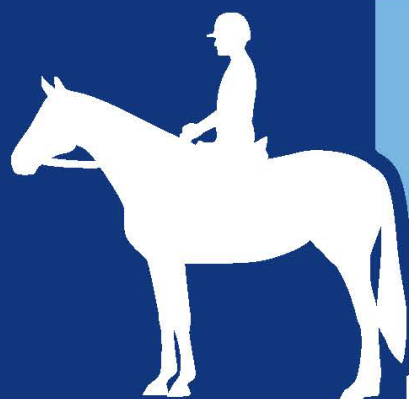
- 11. AMATEUR NON-MEMBER:** Amateur cards are no longer available for non-members. Only active Federation members may obtain amateur certification. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation.
- 12. Management** reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and to cancel award prizes, without claims for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; and to change rings, judges or other officials.
Class Schedules: The Tentative class schedule is included in this booklet. PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: Management reserves the right to adjust the class schedule and class order. If entries warrant, performance may begin earlier or later than published. Please check with the horse show office for each day's final schedule.
- 13. Class Fees.** All regular USEF/Opportunity/Special classes \$25.00. All Regional Class Fees \$50.00.
- 14. Entries:** To be accepted, the entry blank must be COMPLETELY filled out and accompanied by a check covering all fees, plus proof of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus vaccinations within six months of show dates (see GR845) and proof of a current negative Coggins Test within twelve months of show dates for all horses. In addition, for out-of-state horses, Federal law requires a health certificate within 30 days of traveling. In the case of a minor the entry blank must be signed by the parent or guardian. If there is no trainer, the entry blank **must be signed by the owner**. Also include as applicable: copies of front and back of Horse Certificate of Registration, USEF membership card, IALHA/IFSHA membership card, and, if applicable, USEF Amateur Card. No entry will be accepted and processed without above. Credit cards are also accepted with a convenience fee of 3%.
- 15. Refunds.** Entries will only be refunded (less a \$25 handling fee) if a Vet Certificate is received within five days of the event. No re-funds on stabling fees. If classes are canceled due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees will be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation. *Class Scratch refunds will no longer be allowed without a note from the vet. You are welcome to exchange a class for the same horse and same rider. Please do this at the time of the scratch.
- 16. Federation Fees.** For every horse participating in any competition recognized by the Federation, a \$23.00 Federation fee will be collected (\$8.00 is for USEF) and (\$15.00 shall be a drug and medications fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see Federation GR407.1, 2, 3.)).
- 17. USEF Single Event Show Pass Fee** is due from any participant in an Open or Junior Rider class (including at least one owner per horse) who does not have a current USEF membership card.
- 18. Office Fee.** There is an Office Fee of \$30 per horse.
- 19. Andalusian Membership.** An IALHA non-member fee of \$25 per horse will be assessed if applicable. Andalusian Non-Member Participation. An annual Non-Member Participation Fee of \$25 per person will be assessed if applicable.
- 20. Friesian Membership.** All owners and horses must be members of IFSHA. All others must either be a member of IFSHA or pay the appropriate non-member fee (\$25 adults/\$20 juniors).
- 21. Stalls,** whether occupied by horses, feed or tack, will be available for a fee of \$30 per day. (No first bedding)
- 22. Stall availability.** 10' x 10' stalls, with doors, will be available on Thursday, August 4th, 2022, after 9AM. Early Arrivals MUST be pre-arranged with Sandy Jacob (608) 201-5922 by July 13th, 2022. Early Arrivals will be charged \$35.00 per stall per day.
- 23. Grounds Fees.** The fee for trailering in (Grounds Fee) is \$20 per horse, per day.
- 24. Bedding** is available at the show for a fee of \$9 per square; pick up at Show Office. **Feed and hay:** Bring your own.
- 25.** In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, restricting disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste (sharps) containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste.
- 26. Class Calls.** Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA System and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA System to carry class calls, however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed based on PA malfunctions alone. The two-minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The in gate will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring.
- 27. Protective Headgear.** Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.
- 28. Food Service.** During the competition, food service will be provided on the competition grounds.
- 29. Camping.** RV parking is available on the grounds for a fee of \$40 per night for Electric/Water and \$25 per night for no Electric/Water.
- 30. Dogs** must be on leashes no longer than 6 feet. No loose dogs allowed.
- 31. Warm Up Arena** is 60 x 120 meters and is composed of sand and clay
- 32. Show Arena** is indoors and is 60 x 120 meters and is composed of sand.
- 33. Horse Show Office** will be open Thursday, August 4th from 10 AM to 7 PM. The office will open one hour prior to the first session each day and remain open for 30 minutes after the last class each day. The Horse Show Office telephone number is (314) 717-7683.
